Build a long-range research architecture

Organize publications around two or three coherent scholarly themes. Senior academic progression is strengthened when individual publications form a recognizable body of work rather than an unrelated list.

Balance continuity and quality

Use a rolling pipeline with completed work, active submissions and future projects. Review journal quality, editorial fit, research ethics, authorship roles and the contribution each article makes to the larger academic profile.

Develop visibility

Keep ORCID and academic profiles accurate, use consistent author naming, preserve DOI records, and make lawful open versions available where appropriate. Track citations and scholarly engagement without treating metrics as the only measure of quality.

Connect scholarship to leadership

Professor-level preparation should also document mentoring, teaching leadership, supervision, institutional service, interdisciplinary collaboration and contributions to academic communities.

Assemble the senior dossier

At the internal 40-article benchmark, prepare a senior dossier with a clear research narrative, selected high-impact outputs, evidence of leadership and a future agenda for institutional review.

ACA guidance materials are designed for academic planning and dossier preparation. Formal institutional decisions remain with the competent institution.
